30 from the legislative service office and executive branch agencies  
31 while conducting the study required by this section. Not later  
32 than December 1, 2025, the management audit committee shall report  
33 to the management council on the conclusion of the study required  
34 by this section. The report shall include, but not necessarily be  
35 limited to, the appropriate legislative role in overseeing  
36 administrative rules and the regulatory impact thereof, the  
37 legislative staff required to assist the legislature in completing  
38 this role, which legislative body should oversee this role when  
39 the legislature is not in session and any statutory changes  
40 necessary to effectuate the findings in the report. The management  
41 audit committee or management council may sponsor legislation  
42 during the 2026 budget session to effectuate the findings of the  
43 report. Funding for legislative staff necessary to effectuate the  
44 findings of the report required by this section may be included in  
45 the 2025 legislative appropriations bill."
