AN ACT relating to immigration; establishing offenses related to the transportation, concealment or hiring of illegal or unauthorized aliens; providing penalties; requiring the verification of citizenship status for public benefits as specified; requiring the attorney general and each county sheriff to negotiate with federal agencies concerning immigration as specified; specifying requirements for communicating information related to immigration status for inmates; requiring documentation concerning citizenship for the issuance of driver's licenses and identification cards; providing and amending definitions; requiring reports; specifying applicability; requiring rulemaking; and providing for effective dates.

"Section 4. There is appropriated one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve account to the office of the attorney general for purposes of providing reimbursements to counties for expenses incurred in implementing this act that are not reimbursed by the United States or a federal agency and for reimbursement for expenses for anti-terrorism training. Reimbursements shall be made to each county for expenses under this section, except that if the amount of reimbursements exceed the amount of this appropriation, reimbursements shall be made in the proportion that the population of the county bears to the total state population. After July 1, 2027, the attorney general shall reimburse expenses on a first come, first served basis. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this section and ending June 30, 2028. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and 9-4-207, this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2028.".
