"(f) Any public officer, as defined in W.S. 6-5-101(a)(v), who knowingly violates subsection (a) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, a fine of not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), or both.

(g) Nothing in this section shall be construed to:

(i) Preclude any investigation and lawful seizure of firearms, accessories or ammunition related to violations of Wyoming law;

(ii) Impose liability for civil penalties under this section on individual public officers or peace officers.".
