Notice required of driver. 11 12 (a) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident 13 resulting in injury to or death of any person, in property 14 damage to another or others to an apparent extent of at least one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or in any vehicle, 15

4	of communication give notice of the accident to:

6	(i) The local police department if the accident

10	patrol or to the office of the county sheriff.

12	(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall only apply
13	if the accident results in:

15	(i) Injury to or death of any person; or

1 2 (c) Every police officer who investigates a motor 3 vehicle accident resulting shall forward a written report of the accident to the highway department within ten (10) 4 days after his investigation of the accident if the motor 5 vehicle accident results in: 6 7 8 (i) Bodily injury to or death of any person; or 9 10 (ii) Total property damage to an apparent the extent of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or more the 11 12 vehicle is so disabled as to prevent its normal and safe operation, either: 13 14 15 (A) At the time of and at the scene of the 16 accident; or thereafter by interviewing the participants or 17 witnesses shall forward a written report of the accident to the highway department within ten (10) days after his 18 19 investigation of the accident. 20 21 (B) After the motor vehicle has been moved from the scene of the accident and the police officer is 22

4	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
