1	(c) An applicant who is the holder of an expiring
2	lease, and has paid the rental when due, and has is not
3	violated currently in violation of the provisions of the
4	lease, and is qualified under the provisions of W.S.
5	36-5-101, shall have a preferred right to renew such lease
6	by meeting the highest bid offered by another qualified
7	applicant whose bid is not less than the minimum fair
8	market value as determined by the board for the same or a
9	similar use of land using the formula developed pursuant to
10	W.S. 36-5-101(b) and not more than one hundred twenty
11	percent (120%) of the maximum fair market value as
12	determined by the board based on the previous year's values
13	for the state, district or county, whichever is most
14	localized and available, as determined by the national
15	agricultural statistics service utilizing:

Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 19 20 Constitution.
