Definitions. 14 (a) As used in this act: 15

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1 2 (xxxii) "Cultivated meat" means meat that is 3 grown entirely in a laboratory from cultured animal cells 4 rather than harvested from an animal; 5 6 (xxxii) (xxxiii) "This act" means W.S. 35-7-109 7 through 35-7-126. 8 9 35-7-111. Prohibited acts. 10 11 (a) No person shall: 12 (xiv) Manufacture for sale, sell, offer for sale 13 or distribute for sale cultivated meat for human 14 15 consumption in this state. 16 17 35-7-125. Summary suspension of a license. 18 19 (a) A regulatory authority may summarily suspend a 20 license to operate a food establishment if it determines through consultation with a health officer, inspection, 21 examination of food, employees, records or other authorized 22 23 means that an establishment is manufacturing for sale,

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1 selling, offering for sale or distributing for sale 2 cultivated meat for human consumption or an imminent health 3 hazard exists including, but not limited to, fire, flood, 4 extended interruption of electrical or water service, or sewage backup. 5 6 7 **Section 2.** The department of agriculture shall 8 promulgate all rules necessary to implement this act. 9 Section 3. 10 11 12 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of 13 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2025. 14 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective 15 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a 16 17 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 18 19 20 (END)

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
