

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0183

Net metering amendments.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to electric utilities; amending the  
2 generation capacity for net metering systems; providing for  
3 the aggregation of net metering systems; authorizing  
4 customer-generators with specified net metering systems to  
5 charge a customer-generator fee or increase in a monthly  
6 fee; providing and amending definitions; and providing for  
7 an effective date.

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9 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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11 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-16-101(a)(intro), (viii)(B) and by  
12 creating a new paragraph (ix) and 37-16-102(a)(iii) and by  
13 creating a new paragraph (iv) are amended to read:

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15 **37-16-101. Definitions.**

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2 (a) As used in this chapter, unless the context or a  
3 specific article otherwise requires:

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5 (viii) "Net metering system" means a facility  
6 for the production of electrical energy that:

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8 (B) Has a generating capacity of not more  
9 than:

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11 (I) Twenty-five (25) kilowatts per  
12 meter for residential use;

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14 (II) Two hundred (200) kilowatts per  
15 meter for nonresidential use.

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17 (ix) "Primary feeder" means a power line or  
18 other facility that carries electricity directly from a  
19 substation to distribution transformers.

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21 **37-16-102. Electric utility requirements.**

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23 (a) An electric utility:

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2 (iii) Shall not charge a customer-generator any  
3 fee or charge that would increase the customer-generator's  
4 minimum monthly charge to an amount greater than that of  
5 other customers of the electric utility in the same rate  
6 class as the customer-generator unless a customer-generator  
7 is operating a net metering system with a generating  
8 capacity over twenty-five (25) kilowatts and the commission  
9 approves the fee or charge;

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11 (iv) Shall, upon request from a  
12 customer-generator, aggregate an additional meter that is  
13 physically attached to the net metering system with one (1)  
14 or more designated meters, if:

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16 (A) The additional meter is located on the  
17 customer-generator's premises;

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19 (B) The electricity is for the  
20 customer-generator's use;

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22 (C) The designated meter and the additional  
23 meter are subject to the same rate schedule; and

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(D) The designated meter and the additional  
meter are served by the same primary feeder.

**Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
