for

1 AN ACT relating to public utilities; repealing low-carbon
2 energy standard requirements; repealing conflicting
3 provisions; making conforming amendments; specifying
4 applicability; requiring rulemaking; and providing for an
5 effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-1-101(a)(intro) and 37-2-134(a)(i)
10 and (iv) are amended to read:

12 **37-1-101. Definitions.**

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14 (a) As used in chapters 1, 2, 3, 12, and 17 ~~and 18~~ of
15 this title:

2 **37-2-134. Electric generation facility closures;**
3 **presumption; commission review.**

5 (a) As used in this section:

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7 (i) "Dispatchable" means ~~as defined in W.S.~~
8 ~~37-18-101(a)(ii)~~ a source of electricity that is available
9 for use on demand and that can be dispatched upon request
10 of a power grid operator or that can have its power output
11 adjusted, according to market needs and includes
12 dispatchability;

14 (iv) "Reliable" means ~~as defined in W.S.~~
15 ~~37-18-101(a)(iv)~~ generated electricity that is not subject
16 to intermittent availability.

18 **Section 2.** W.S. 37-1-101(a)(vi)(N), 37-18-101 and
19 37-18-102 are repealed.

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21 **Section 3.** The public service commission shall
22 promulgate all rules necessary to implement this act.

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1 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
