A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;  
2 providing an expiration date for executive orders as  
3 specified; specifying applicability; and providing for an  
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-225 is created to read:

9

10 **9-1-225. Executive orders; expiration.**

11

12 Unless a newly elected governor issues an executive order  
13 extending a lawfully issued executive order, executive  
14 orders issued by the previous governor of this state shall

1 expire thirty (30) days after the previous governor leaves  
2 office. No executive order shall be effective for longer  
3 than thirty (30) days after the governor who issued the  
4 order leaves office.

5

6 **Section 2.** This act applies to any executive order  
7 currently in effect or issued on or after July 1, 2025.

8

9 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
