1 or unattached to real property and designed, installed and elimination, 2 utilized primarily for the control or 3 prevention of air, water or land pollution, or in the event 4 such facility, installation, equipment or machinery shall 5 also serve other beneficial purposes and use, such portion of the assessed valuation thereof as may be reasonably 6 7 calculated to be necessary for and devoted to elimination, 8 control or prevention of air, water and land pollution. The 9 department of revenue shall determine the exempt portion on 10 all property assessed pursuant to W.S. 39-13-102(m). The 11 county assessor shall determine the exempt portion on all 12 property assessed pursuant to W.S. 39-13-103(b). The 13 determination shall not include as exempt any portion of any facilities which have value as the specific source of 14 marketable byproducts or facilities constructed for the 15 16 sole purpose of capturing nonpoint source carbon dioxide.
