A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to state lands; allowing the fencing of  
2 state lands and maintenance of fencing as specified;  
3 requiring rulemaking; and providing for effective dates.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-28-106 by creating a new  
8 subsection (c) is amended to read:

9

10 **11-28-106. Construction and maintenance of partition**  
11 **fences; fencing of state lands.**

13 (c) Landowners whose property adjoins state lands on  
14 which the landowner does not hold a lease may construct a  
15 lawful partition fence along state lands and the office of

1 state lands and investments or, if the state lands are  
2 currently leased, the lessee of the state lands shall pay  
3 for one-half (1/2) of the actual cost of the construction  
4 of the lawful partition fence. Landowners and the office of  
5 state lands and investments, or the lessee at all times  
6 that the state lands are leased, shall contribute to the  
7 cost of maintenance of the lawful partition fence in  
8 proportion to their respective interests in the fence.

9  
10 **Section 2.** The board of land commissioners shall  
11 promulgate all rules necessary to implement this act.

12  
13 **Section 3.**

14  
15 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this  
16 section, this act is effective July 1, 2025.

17  
18 (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective  
19 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
20 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
21 the Wyoming Constitution.
