There is appropriated four hundred 19 forty-one thousand three hundred forty dollars 20 (\$441,340.00) from the general fund to the department of 21 state parks and cultural resources for the purposes of 22 surveying, documenting and three-dimensional modeling, 23 internally or through a consultant, all known petroglyphs

1 and pictographs on state, school and institutional land in 2 Wyoming. No survey conducted pursuant to this section shall 3 access private lands without first notifying and consulting 4 with the landowner. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the effective date of this act and 5 ending June 30, 2028. This appropriation shall not be 6 7 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any 8 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this 9 appropriation shall not revert until June 30, 2028. It is 10 the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be included in the department of state parks and cultural 11 12 resources' standard budget for the immediately succeeding 13 fiscal biennium.
