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20	(i) "Resident school district" means the school
21	district where the pupil resides;

2	area designed by a school district to determine which
3	public school a pupil is eligible to attend within their

7	decline to enroll a pupil in a public school within the
8	pupil's resident school district for the following reasons:
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10	(i) The public school does not have sufficient
11	capacity at the appropriate grade level as determined by
12	the school district; or
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14	(ii) The pupil has been suspended or expelled or
15	is in the process of being suspended or expelled under W.S.
16	21-4-305 and 21-4-306.
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18	(e) In implementing the provisions of subsection (c)
19	of this section, no school district board of trustees shall
20	be required to establish and offer any particular program
21	in a public school if the program is not currently offered
22	in the school. No school district shall be required to
23	provide transportation to a student who enrolls at a school

3	provided transportation under the school district's

7	shall publish the number of vacancies open for enrollment
