## A BILL

1	AN ACT relating to education; providing definitions;
2	requiring a kindergarten through grade eight (8) public lab
3	school; specifying the purpose of the public lab school;
4	creating a governing board; specifying membership of the
5	governing board; specifying duties of the governing board;
6	specifying enrollment requirements and preferences;
7	specifying funding; requiring reporting; specifying the
8	first year of enrollment; and providing for an effective
9	date.
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11	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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13	<b>Section 1</b> . W.S. 21-17-501 through 21-17-504 are
14	created to read:

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1 2 ARTICLE 5 3 TEACHER EDUCATION K-8 PUBLIC LAB SCHOOL 4 21-17-501. Creation of a K-8 public lab school; 5 6 purpose. 7 8 (a) There is created a public lab school to teach 9 kindergarten through grade eight (8) to accomplish the following purposes: 10 11 (i) Promote developmentally appropriate 12 differentiated instruction that is model learner-centered 13 14 for students; 15 (ii) Serves as a teacher education institution 16 17 and educational learning site for pre-service teachers of all levels; 18 19 20 (iii) Identifies best teaching practices that can be utilized in public schools statewide. 21 22

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1 (b) The public lab school established pursuant to 2 subsection (a) of this section shall be a coordinated 3 effort between the University of Wyoming and the resident 4 school district. For purposes of this article, "resident 5 school district" means the public school district that is 6 located where the University of Wyoming's main campus is 7 located.

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(c) The public lab school established pursuant to 9 10 subsection (a) of this section shall be an independent public school within the resident school district and shall 11 12 be accountable to the governing board established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-502 for purposes of ensuring compliance with 13 and the requirements of the 14 applicable laws state 15 constitution.

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17 (d) The public lab school established pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall be located on the main 18 19 campus of the University of Wyoming. Any contract executed 20 between the governing body, established by W.S. 21 21-17-502(a), and the University of Wyoming shall be subject to the provisions of W.S. 21-17-502(b). 22

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1 21-17-502. Creation of a governing board; membership; 2 duties. 3 4 (a) There is created a governing board to consist of seven (7) voting members and one (1) ex-officio, nonvoting 5 member to govern the operation of the public lab school 6 established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501. The governing board 7 8 shall consist of the following eight (8) members: 9 (i) One (1) member that serves on the resident 10 11 school district's board of trustees; 12 (ii) The superintendent of the resident school 13 district, or his designee; 14 15 16 (iii) The dean of the University of Wyoming's 17 college of education, or his designee; 18 19 (iv) One (1) member appointed by the dean of the 20 University of Wyoming's college of education; 21 22 (v) The superintendent of public instruction, or his designee; 23

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2 (vi) One (1) teacher that instructs or will 3 instruct at the public lab school established pursuant to 4 W.S. 21-17-501 selected by the teachers that teach at the 5 public lab school; б 7 (vii) One (1) parent of a student that attends or will attend the public lab school established pursuant 8 to W.S. 21-17-501 selected by the parents of students that 9 10 attend the public lab school; 11 12 (viii) The principal of the public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501, who shall serve as 13 the chair of the governing board and as an ex-officio 14 15 member and shall not have the right to vote. 16 17 (b) The governing board may negotiate and contract with the resident school district or the University of 18 19 Wyoming, or any third party for the use of a school 20 building and grounds, the operation and maintenance 21 thereof, and the provision of any service, activity or undertaking that the public lab school established pursuant 22 to W.S. 21-17-501 is required to perform in order to carry 23

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out the educational program. Any services for which the 1 2 governing board contracts for as provided for under this 3 subsection shall be pursuant to a written contract. If the 4 contract is with the resident school district or the University of Wyoming, the services shall be provided by 5 the resident school district or the University of Wyoming б 7 at an incremental cost. 8 (c) The governing board shall have standing to sue 9 10 and be sued in its own name for the enforcement of any 11 contract created pursuant to this section. 12 The governing board shall be responsible for the 13 (d) operation of the public lab school established pursuant to 14 W.S. 21-17-501 including, but not limited to, preparation 15 16 of a budget, contracting for services and personnel 17 matters. 18 19 (e) The governing board, in consultation with the 20 University of Wyoming, shall determine educational placements of students enrolled at the University of 21

22 Wyoming including, but not limited to, students enrolled in

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1 teaching programs, in the public lab school established 2 pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501. 3 4 (f) Not later than September 1, 2025, and each September 1 every year thereafter, the governing board 5 shall report to the joint education interim committee on б the implementation and administration of the public lab 7 8 school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501. The report 9 shall include at minimum: 10 (i) Student achievement data; 11 12 13 (ii) Enrollment; 14 15 (iii) The level of engagement with the 16 University of Wyoming's college of education in student 17 teacher placement; 18 19 (iv) The impact of the school on the University 20 of Wyoming's teaching program; 21 22 (v) Proposed statutory modifications. 23

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1 21-17-503. Admission to the public lab school; 2 operation; curriculum. 3 4 (a) The public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501 shall: 5 б 7 (i) Be authorized to offer any educational 8 program that may be offered by a school district established pursuant to W.S. 21-3-101 through 21-3-104 9 10 unless expressly prohibited by state law; 11 12 (ii) Meet the state uniform educational program standards imposed upon public schools by W.S. 21-9-101 and 13 21-9-102 and the uniform state student content and 14 performance standards prescribed by the state board of 15 education under W.S. 21-2-304, including compliance with 16 17 requirements under the statewide assessment system pursuant to W.S. 21-2-304(a)(v). 18 19 20 (b) The public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501 may operate free from specified school 21 district policies and state regulations. The governing 22 board established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-502 may waive 23

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1 requirements imposed by the resident school district, 2 without seeking approval of the state board of education established pursuant to W.S. 21-2-301. The state board may 3 4 waive state statutory requirements or rules promulgated by the state board, except that the state board shall not 5 waive any statute or rule relating to the assessments or 6 7 standards required to be administered. Upon request of the 8 governing board, the state board shall provide summaries of 9 such regulations and policies to use in preparing a request 10 for a waiver from state regulations. The state department 11 of education established pursuant to W.S. 21-2-104 shall 12 prepare the summary of state regulations within existing appropriations. Any waiver of the resident school district 13 regulations made pursuant to this subsection shall be for 14 the period of the operation of the public lab school 15 16 established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501, except that a 17 waiver of state statutes or regulations by the state board shall be subject to review every two (2) years and may be 18 19 revoked if the waiver is deemed no longer necessary by the 20 state board. Nothing in this subsection shall be deemed to 21 exempt the public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501 from: 22

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1 (i) Any civil rights, health or safety requirements applicable to other public schools in the 2 3 state except as specifically provided in this article; 4 5 (ii) The student assessment and accountability requirements applicable to other public schools; 6 7 (iii) The public records act and public meeting 8 9 requirements applicable to public schools and school 10 districts and any federal or state privacy laws applicable 11 to public schools or school districts. 12 (c) Admission to the public lab school established 13 pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501 shall be open to all students 14 residing within the resident school district to the extent 15 16 there is capacity within the applicable grade level at the 17 school. Capacity of the school shall be as determined by the state construction department established pursuant to 18 19 W.S. 9-2-3001, but in no event shall not exceed two hundred 20 (200) students. If the total number of students applying 21 for enrollment exceeds the capacity of the public lab school, then the school shall hold a blind lottery to 22 23 determine enrollment, except students enrolled in the

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school the previous year shall be granted a seat, and
 students with a sibling enrolled in the school shall be
 given an enrollment preference.

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5 **21-17-504.** Funding for the K-8 public lab school.

7 The public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 8 21-17-501 shall be funded through the education resource block grant model as defined by W.S. 21-13-101(a)(xiv) as a 9 10 kindergarten through grade eight (8) public school within 11 the resident school district. Payment shall be made to the public lab school by the resident school district as 12 13 provided under W.S. 21-3-314(c), unless the resident district and the governing board of the public lab school 14 mutually agree in writing to fund the public lab school in 15 an alternative manner. 16

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18 Section 2.

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(a) The public lab school established pursuant to
W.S. 21-17-501 shall accept students and commence
operations, not later than school year 2025-2026.

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1 (b) The governing board shall begin negotiations upon 2 the effective date of this section to reach any agreements 3 necessary with the resident school district and the 4 University of Wyoming to begin operation of the public lab 5 school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501.

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7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the 8 public lab school established pursuant to W.S. 21-17-501, as created by section 1 of this act, shall not be 9 10 considered a new school by the department of education for 11 purposes of generating resources under W.S. 21-17-504, as 12 created by section 1 of this act, or for the purposes of 13 the foundation program as defined by W.S. 21-13-101(a)(v). To generate the necessary resources to fund the public lab 14 15 school for school year 2025-2026, the department of 16 education shall utilize the data and information from the 17 University of Wyoming Lab School from school year 2024-2025 18 determine the under to necessary resources W.S. 19 21-13-101(a)(v).

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Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon
 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
 Constitution.
