Description of appropriation:

\$200,000 will be used to hire a contractor to develop an Apple or Android application that is compatible to the existing legislative voting system. This application will authenticate the user as a legislator for each open vote and allow them to place their vote electronically within the legislative chambers.

\$50,000 will be used to purchase hardware for each legislator to submit electronic votes.

It is assumed that the proposed electronic voting system will be implemented based on current House and Senate Rules. It is also assumed that more than one floor vote cannot be open at a given time.
