Source of expenditure increase(decrease):

This legislation requires the implementation of online applications for licensure for military service members and military spouses. A&I Professional Licensing Boards is working with a vendor to provide online services for all supported boards. Because temporary licenses for military service members or military spouses are not within the scope of work, this would be considered an enhancement to add this type of application for all twenty (20) boards.

The Professional Licensing Board initially pays for the software from its budget and will be reimbursed by the boards.

Assumptions:

Costs are associated with online software enhancements split evenly between the individual boards at a cost of \$2,500 per unit.

No significant fiscal or personnel impact to the Board of Pharmacy, the Board of Nursing, or the Board of Medicine.
