

FISCAL NOTE

There is no direct fiscal impact to the Wyoming Military Department. However, if this bill passes, the Wyoming National Guard may (or may not) have the capacity or ability to mobilize and provide a response to all situations identified in this bill. As with any mobilization of the Wyoming National Guard, all mobilizations for this bill will involve federal expenditures that will require reimbursement with state funding following established fiscal processes. Any administrative state expenditure by the Wyoming Military Department for mobilization as a result of this legislation will be from existing state appropriations as conduct of the normal operations of the Department.

The fiscal impact to the judicial system is indeterminable due to an unknown number of cases.

No significant fiscal or personnel impact to the Governor's Office.
