1 (h) Each school district board of trustees shall in conjunction with the University of Wyoming, community 2 3 college district boards of trustees or other post secondary 4 education institutions accredited by recognized and accepted accrediting agencies, make post secondary 5 6 education options programs pursuant to this section 7 reasonably accessible to eligible students, which shall 8 include ensuring access to not less than twelve (12) post secondary credit hours to be completed in grades nine (9) 9 10 through twelve (12). Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
