## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to career technical education equipment 2 grants for K-12 public school districts; increasing the 3 maximum grant award; reducing the years required to expend 4 funds for grant eligibility; and providing for an effective 5 date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8

9 Section 1. W.S. 21-13-337(b)(intro) and (c) is 10 amended to read:

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12 21-13-337. Career and technical education equipment
 13 grants; application; criteria; limitations.

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15 (b) A grant awarded under this section shall be for a 16 period of two (2) years and shall not exceed fifty thousand

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dollars (\$50,000.00) seventy-five thousand dollars
(\$75,000.00) per year. Applications for a grant under this
section shall be submitted on a form and in a manner
specified by rule of the department, shall be filed with
the department on or before June 30 to secure a grant
during the immediately succeeding school year and shall at
a minimum include:

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(c) Not later than August 15 of the applicable school 9 10 year and following review of applications submitted under 11 section, the department shall notify applicant this 12 districts of its grant awards and shall provide each applicant district a written statement of the reasons for 13 14 approving or denying the application. No award shall be 15 given to a district unless it has expended, or will expend 16 with the award of the grant requested under this section, 17 the entire amount generated under W.S. 21-13-309(m)(v)(D) 18 for supplies, materials and equipment for career and 19 technical education programs utilizing expenditure data 20 from the immediately preceding  $\frac{five}{(5)}$  two (2) school 21 years from the date of application and amounts from the special reserve fund created under W.S. 21-13-504 for 22 23 supplies, materials and equipment for career and technical

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1 education programs. Further, Preference shall be given to 2 districts that have not received a grant under this section 3 in the immediately preceding five (5) school years from the 4 date of application. If an application is approved, the department shall award the grant from amounts made 5 available by legislative appropriation from the public 6 7 school foundation program account for purposes of this 8 section. 9 10 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
