13 19-13-108. Local programs; authorized; local homeland

14 security plan; coordinators; appointment and removal.

Each political subdivision of this state shall establish a 1 2 local homeland security program in accordance with the 3 state homeland security plan and program. Each political 4 subdivision through the homeland security program will cause to be prepared a local homeland security plan which 5 include actions essential to the recovery and 6 restoration of the economy by supply and resupply of 7 8 resources to meet urgent survival and military needs and to 9 provide for the ongoing management of resources available 10 to meet continuing survival and recovery needs. Each local 11 homeland security plan shall require coordination with each 12 certified water and wastewater operator necessary to 13 provide emergency and public safety services for homeland security. Each local homeland security program shall have a 14 15 appointed coordinator by the governor upon the 16 recommendation of the local jurisdiction. The coordinator 17 responsibility for has direct the organization, administration and operation of the local homeland security 18 program subject to the direction and control of the local 19 20 jurisdiction under the general direction of the governor. 21 The governor may remove any coordinator as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. 22

3 (a) As used in this act:

4

(i) "Emergency responders" means public, state 5 or federal fire services, law enforcement, emergency 6 7 medical services, public health, public works including 8 certified water and wastewater operators, homeland security and other public response services or agencies that would 9 be involved in direct actions to contain or control a 10 hazardous material release, weapons of mass destruction 11 12 incident or clandestine laboratory investigation. The term 13 "emergency responders" does not include private on-site facilities with immediate emergency response capabilities 14 unless formally requested to assist off the private 15 16 facility site by the state or a political subdivision of 17 the state;
