1	(a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of
2	this section, no person shall operate a passenger vehicle
3	in this state unless each child who is a passenger in that
4	vehicle and who has not reached his ninth birthday nine (9)
5	years of age is properly secured in a child safety
6	restraint system in a seat of the vehicle other than the
7	front seat, except if the vehicle is only equipped with one
8	(1) row of seats, or if all safety belts in the rows of
9	seats behind the front seat are in use by other child
10	passengers in the vehicle, the a child may be properly
11	secured in a child safety restraint system in the front
12	passenger seat of the vehicle, except that a rear-facing
13	infant seat child safety restraint system shall not be
14	placed in front of an active airbag. The child safety
15	restraint system required by this subsection shall be
16	rear-facing until the child reaches either the age of two
17	(2) or the maximum weight or height limit specified by the
18	manufacturer of the child safety restraint system for rear-
19	facing installation.
