W.S. 21-3-137 is created to read: 9 10 21-3-137. School safety and security policies. 11 12 (a) Each school district board of trustees shall adopt safety and security policies, including threat 13 14 assessment procedures. 15

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1 (b) The superintendent of each school district shall 2 implement the safety and security policies adopted under 3 subsection (a) of this section.

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(c) A school district's safety and security policies 5 and drafts of the policies shall be confidential and shall 6 not be deemed a public record available for public 7 8 inspection under the Public Records Act. Each school district board of trustees may develop, discuss and review 9 10 safety and security policies under this section in 11 executive session not open to the public under W.S. 12 16-4-405(a)(ix) and (xii).

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Section 2. W.S. 21-3-110(a) by creating a new paragraph (xliv) and 35-9-107 by creating a new subsection (d) are amended to read:

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18 **21-3-110.** Duties of boards of trustees.

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20 (a) The board of trustees in each school district 21 shall:

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1	(xliv) Adopt school safety and security policies
2	in accordance with W.S. 21-3-137.
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4	35-9-107. Duties and powers of state fire marshal.
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б	(d) The state fire marshal shall not prohibit the use
7	of a door securement device used under a school safety and
8	security policy adopted under W.S. 21-3-137. The state fire
9	marshal may adopt rules regulating the use of door
10	securement devices, including requiring that door
11	securement devices only be deployed to address active
12	threats or during safety drills under W.S. 35-9-505.
