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section. Funds appropriated under this section shall not be 1 2 distributed to the governor's office before April 1, 2025

3 and only if this bill becomes effective under section 2 of

4 this act. The study funded by this appropriation shall:

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(i) Be conducted by an independent third party; 6

transportation, highways and military affairs interim 9

committee; 10

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12 (iii) Evaluate the department of

transportation's rules, policies and procedures; 13

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(iv) Review the department of transportation's 15

staffing and resources and the distribution and number of 16

17 staff and resources around the state of Wyoming;

including the department's standard specifications for 21

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1 (vi) Conduct an anonymous survey of all 2 employees of the department of transportation asking for 3 employees to identify areas for increasing efficiencies 4 within the department; 5 (vii) Determine whether efficiencies or 6 cost 7 savings can be gained; 8 9 (viii) Provide recommendations for the 10 department of transportation to achieve the efficiencies identified in paragraphs (vi) and (vii) of this subsection; 11 12 13 (ix) Include a final report, containing the potential efficiencies identified, recommendations to 14 achieve those efficiencies and any recommendations for 15 16 changes to statute, rule, policy or procedure to the 17 governor, the department of transportation and the joint transportation, highways and military affairs 18 interim 19 committee not later than July 1, 2026. 20 21 Section 2.
