1	(c) An applicant who is the holder of an expiring
2	lease, and has paid the rental when due, and has is not
3	violated in violation of the provisions of the lease, and
4	is qualified under the provisions of W.S. 36-5-101, shall
5	have a preferred right to renew such lease by meeting the
6	highest bid offered by another qualified applicant whose
7	bid is not less than the minimum fair market value as
8	determined by the board for the same or a similar use of
9	land using the formula developed pursuant to W.S.
10	36-5-101(b) and not more than one hundred twenty percent
11	(120%) of the maximum fair market value as determined by
12	the board based on the previous year's values for the
13	state, district or county, whichever is most localized and
14	available, as determined by the national agricultural
15	statistics service utilizing:
