8 **Section 1**. W.S. 6-4-101 and 6-4-102 are amended to

11 6-4-101. Prostitution; definitions; penalties.

13 (a) As used in this section:

14

(i) "Intimate parts" means as defined by W.S. 6-2-301(a)(ii);(ii) "Sexual contact" means touching, with the intention of sexual arousal, gratification or abuse, of another person's intimate parts by the actor, or of the actor's intimate parts by the other person, or of the clothing covering the immediate area of another person's intimate parts. (b) Except as provided in W.S. 6-2-701 through 6-2-710, a person who knowingly or intentionally performs 13 or permits, or offers or agrees to perform or permit an act of sexual intrusion, as defined by W.S. 6-2-301(a)(vii), or 14 an act of sexual contact, as defined by paragraph (a)(ii) 15 16 of this section, for money or other property commits 17 prostitution which is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of 18 not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or 19 20 both. 6-4-102. 2 Except as provided in W.S. 6-2-701 through 6-2-710, a

3 person is guilty of soliciting an act of prostitution if,

4 with the intent that an act of sexual intrusion as defined

5 by W.S. 6-2-301(a)(vii) or an act of sexual contact as

6 defined by W.S. 6-4-101(a)(ii) be committed, that person

7 knowingly or intentionally pays, or offers or agrees to pay

8 money or other property to another person under

9 circumstances strongly corroborative of the intention that

10 an act of prostitution be committed. Soliciting an act of

11 prostitution is a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment

12 for not more than six (6) months, a fine of not more than

13 seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or both.

15 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
