The secretary of state shall preserve all other 12 proclamations of the governor for one (1) year and then deliver them to the department of state parks and cultural 13 resources for destruction or preservation as it deems 14 15 desirable. As used in this paragraph, "executive order" 16 means a proclamation or order executed by the governor 17 pursuant to constitutional or statutory authority to 18 implement any provision of law; provided "executive order" 19 does not include: 20 21 (A) A proclamation issued by the governor

4 secretary of state's official website as soon as reasonably

5 practicable in accordance with this act. The requirements

6 of this section shall include executive orders that have

7 expired.

9 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2025.
