11 (a) There is created the monument to America

12 development and oversight task force to consist of the

7 (i) Develop preliminary specifications, plans 8 and features for the monument to America in recognition of the upcoming two hundred and fifty (250) year anniversary 9 10 of the signing of the Declaration of Independence. The 11 monument to America shall be similar in size and scope to 12 the Mount Rushmore national monument and shall feature 13 important historical American figures as recommended by the including native American 14 force leaders. 2 (\$40,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's office

3 to pay compensation, mileage and per diem for

4 nonlegislative members of the task force. This

5 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the

6 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2027. This

7 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any

8 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

9 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided

10 by law on June 30, 2027.

12 (b) There is appropriated forty thousand dollars

13 (\$40,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative

14 service office to pay for salary, mileage and per diem of

15 active legislative members appointed to the task force.

16 This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with

17 the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2027.

18 This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for

19 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

20 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided

21 by law on June 30, 2027.

1 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

 $2\,$  completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
