Senior citizen service districts-authorization and renewal.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to counties; amending the length of time
2 for approval of a mill levy proposition for senior citizen
3 service districts; amending the process for reconsidering
4 mill levies for senior citizen service districts; and
5 providing for an effective date.

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7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-15-102(d) is amended to read:

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11 **18-15-102. Formation of district; mill levy.**

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13 (d) If the proposition to authorize a mill levy is
14 approved by the qualified electors of the proposed district
15 under subsection (c) of this section, the proposition to

1 impose a levy in the same or at a different amount not to
2 exceed two (2) mills, shall be submitted to the resident
3 electors within the proposed district at the first general
4 election held ~~two (2)~~ four (4) years after the election
5 authorizing the district. ~~and every four (4) years~~
6 ~~thereafter, until defeated.~~ If the proposition to impose or
7 continue a mill levy is defeated, the proposition shall not
8 be submitted to the electors for a period of not less than
9 one (1) year. If the proposition to continue a mill levy
10 under this subsection is approved, the mill levy shall
11 continue until a proposition to rescind the mill levy is
12 submitted to the resident electors of the district and is
13 approved at the next general election after:

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15 (i) The adoption of a resolution by the board of
16 county commissioners proposing to rescind the mill levy; or

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18 (ii) The board of county commissioners receives
19 a petition to rescind the mill levy signed by qualified
20 electors resident in the district equal in number to not
21 less than fifteen percent (15%) of the voters resident in
22 the district who voted in the last general election. The

1 county clerk shall verify the signatures before
2 consideration by the board.

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4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
