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13 **Section 1**. W.S. 9-3-220(a)(ii), (b) and (c) is

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(a) Volunteer

8 technicians and volunteer search and rescue persons may 9 elect to participate in the state employees' and officials' 10 group insurance plan as defined by W.S. 9-3-203(a)(v) and 11 implemented under W.S. 9-3-202 through 9-3-219. These 12 volunteers are eligible to enroll in the group insurance 13 plan within the first thirty-one (31) days of the enactment of this section or after initially volunteering for ninety 14 (90) days. After the ninety (90) day period is over, the 15 16 volunteer shall have thirty-one (31) days to enroll in the 17 group insurance plan. Eligible volunteers who elect not to 18 enrolled within the time prescribed become in this 19 subsection may be enrolled at a later date upon conditions 20 the department may impose. Continued participation in the 21 program is limited to a volunteer who:

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1 (ii) Is not eligible for health insurance 2 coverage under a government sponsored health care program 3 excluding the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, 4 P.L. 111-148, marketplace exchange; and 5 (b) Volunteer firefighters, volunteer emergency 6 medical technicians and volunteer search and rescue persons 7 8 participating in the state employees' and officials' group insurance plan shall pay their group insurance <u>be</u> 9 10 responsible for submitting their monthly premiums in their 11 entirety and shall not benefit from to the department. An 12 employer, contributions to cover a portion of the cost of their premiums. Volunteers shall submit their monthly 13 14 premiums to the fire department, emergency medical service 15 department or search and rescue department may elect to 16 contribute a portion of the cost of a volunteer's premium. 17 The procedure for submittal of premiums shall be 18 established by the department. 19 20 (c) Volunteer firefighters, volunteer emergency 21 medical technicians and volunteer search and rescue persons participating in the state employees' and officials' group 22 insurance plan shall submit monthly annual verification of 23

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1 their continued volunteer status to the department. The

2 verification shall be reviewed and signed by their

3 supervisor.
