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- 14 (d) No later than forty-five (45) days after the date
- 15 of the primary election, the county canvassing board or a

3 each county chairman the certified election results for

4 precinct committeemen and committeewomen and a list of

5 persons who received write-in votes for precinct

10 The county canvassing board is the county clerk and two (2) electors of different political parties resident in who are 11 12 residents of the county, appointed with one (1) elector 13 selected by the county clerk—central committee of each of 14 the two (2) largest major political parties in the county. 15 If there are not two (2) major political parties in the 16 county, or if a county central committee fails to select an elector for the county canvassing board under this section, 17 18 the county clerk may appoint any unfilled positions on the 19 county canvassing board, provided that the two (2) electors 20 shall be of different political parties. The two (2) 21 electors shall receive the same compensation as election judges. All canvassing board members shall take an oath of 22

3 than mail ballot elections; canvass, recount and contests.

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(e) Any special district election conducted by the 5 county clerk shall be canvassed by the county canvassing 6 board. or a canvassing board appointed by the county clerk, 7 8 consisting of two (2) electors and the county clerk. If 9 more than one (1) county is involved, the election shall be 10 canvassed in accordance with chapter 16 of the Wyoming Election Code of 1973, as amended, by a canvassing board 11 drawn from the membership of the appropriate county 12 13 canvassing boards appointed by the appropriate county commissioners. The commissioners shall notify the county 14 15 clerks of the canvassing board appointments. Any special 16 district election not conducted by a county clerk shall be 17 canvassed by a special district canvassing board. The special district canvassing board shall consist of 18 19 district secretary and two (2) electors appointed by the 20 district board. Any canvass shall be conducted accordance with chapter 16 of the Wyoming Election Code of 21 1973, as amended. The canvass shall be conducted within 22 seven (7) business days of the election. The canvassing 23

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1 board shall have the authority to call for a special
