A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; specifying the membership of  
2 the county canvassing board; making conforming changes; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-4-101(d), 22-16-101 and  
8 22-29-114(e)(intro) are amended to read:

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10 **22-4-101. Application; composition, election and**  
11 **qualifications of county central committees; certificate of**  
12 **election.**

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14 (d) No later than forty-five (45) days after the date  
15 of the primary election, the county canvassing board ~~or a~~

1 ~~canvassing board appointed by the county clerk consisting~~  
2 ~~of two (2) electors and the county clerk,~~ shall provide to  
3 each county chairman the certified election results for  
4 precinct committeemen and committeewomen and a list of  
5 persons who received write-in votes for precinct  
6 committeemen or committeewomen.

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8 **22-16-101. County canvassing board; compensation.**

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10 The county canvassing board is the county clerk and two (2)  
11 electors ~~of different political parties resident in~~ who are  
12 residents of the county, ~~appointed~~ with one (1) elector  
13 selected by the county ~~clerk~~ central committee of each of  
14 the two (2) largest major political parties in the county.  
15 If there are not two (2) major political parties in the  
16 county, or if a county central committee fails to select an  
17 elector for the county canvassing board under this section,  
18 the county clerk may appoint any unfilled positions on the  
19 county canvassing board, provided that the two (2) electors  
20 shall be of different political parties. The two (2)  
21 electors shall receive the same compensation as election  
22 judges. All canvassing board members shall take an oath of  
23 office.

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2           **22-29-114. Election procedures for elections other**  
3 **than mail ballot elections; canvass, recount and contests.**

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5           (e) Any special district election conducted by the  
6 county clerk shall be canvassed by the county canvassing  
7 board. ~~or a canvassing board appointed by the county clerk,~~  
8 ~~consisting of two (2) electors and the county clerk.~~ If  
9 more than one (1) county is involved, the election shall be  
10 canvassed in accordance with chapter 16 of the Wyoming  
11 Election Code of 1973, as amended, by a canvassing board  
12 drawn from the membership of the appropriate county  
13 canvassing boards appointed by the appropriate county  
14 commissioners. The commissioners shall notify the county  
15 clerks of the canvassing board appointments. Any special  
16 district election not conducted by a county clerk shall be  
17 canvassed by a special district canvassing board. The  
18 special district canvassing board shall consist of the  
19 district secretary and two (2) electors appointed by the  
20 district board. Any canvass shall be conducted in  
21 accordance with chapter 16 of the Wyoming Election Code of  
22 1973, as amended. The canvass shall be conducted within  
23 seven (7) business days of the election. The canvassing

1 board shall have the authority to call for a special  
2 election in accordance with W.S. 22-16-122. The canvassing  
3 board shall:
