1 AN ACT relating to elections; requiring a qualified elector to be a bona fide resident of the state of Wyoming for not 2 less than thirty (30) days before the date of the election 3 in which they offer to vote; requiring documentation 4 5 proving residence to register to vote; prohibiting registration based on documentation showing noncitizen б 7 status; making conforming amendments; requiring rulemaking; 8 and providing for effective dates. 9 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

Qualifications; temporary registration. 10 11 (a) A person may register to vote not less than 12 fourteen (14) days before an election, at any election specified in W.S. 22-2-101(a)(i) through (viii) or as 13 provided by W.S. 22-3-117, who satisfies the following 14 qualifications: 15 16 17 (i) He is a citizen of the United States. The county clerk shall not register a person if the person's 18 19 presented identification or proof of residence contains any 20 indication that the person is not a citizen of the United 21 States unless the person also presents proof of citizenship as specified by rule of the secretary of state. 4 (a) Notwithstanding any other section or provision in 5 this chapter, any citizen of the United States who is a resident of Wyoming may apply for registration by providing 6 information required by W.S. 22-3-103(a), and 7 the acceptable identification to and proof of residence and 8 completing and subscribing, the form of voter registration 9 10 oath prescribed by W.S. 22-3-103(b) before any person authorized by law to administer oaths. Each county clerk 11 12 shall furnish the voter registration oath forms. The 13 applicant shall mail or return the completed voter registration oath form to the county clerk in the county in 14 which the applicant resides. In order to vote in the next 15 16 election, the application must be received in the county 17 clerk's office before the close of registration for that 18 election, or:
