A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public utilities; requiring customer  
2 allocation agreements for utility service to a customer in  
3 the certificated territory of another utility; authorizing  
4 a civil action and recovery for violations; and providing  
5 for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 37-2-205 by creating a new subsection  
10 (k) is amended to read:

11

12 **37-2-205. Certificate of convenience and necessity;**  
13 **hearings.**

1       (k) No person or entity shall sell electricity for  
2 use by a customer in another public utility's certificated  
3 service territory, including by providing service to a  
4 point of delivery outside of the other public utility's  
5 certificated territory for consumption within the other  
6 public utility's certificated territory, without a customer  
7 allocation agreement between the customer, the seller of  
8 the electricity and the other public utility. Any violation  
9 of this subsection shall entitle the aggrieved public  
10 utility to recover in a civil action damages for lost  
11 income from the unlawful invasion of its certificated  
12 service territory, plus all reasonable attorney fees and  
13 expenses incurred by the aggrieved public utility in the  
14 civil action brought under this subsection.

16       **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
