1 AN ACT relating to the legislature; requiring the 2 legislative service office to live broadcast legislative meetings to the public as specified; and providing for an 3 4 effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 8 Section 1. W.S. 28-8-105(a) by creating a new 9 paragraph (vii) is amended to read: 10 11 28-8-105. Duties of director and staff; prefiling 12 bills; fiscal notes.

1 It shall be the duty of the director and staff to (a) 2 perform the following specific functions, together with 3 such other functions as the council may prescribe: 4 (vii) Make available to the public a live, video 5 broadcast of each meeting of management council, the joint 6 7 appropriations committee, the management audit committee, a 8 joint interim committee, a select committee or task force 9 that is staffed by the legislative service office. A copy 10 of the broadcast shall thereafter be made available on the website of the legislature. The contents of any broadcast 11 12 made under this paragraph shall not be construed to supersede the official written record of the meeting that 13 reflects formal action or recommendation when approved by 14 15 the committee or task force chairman. Nothing in this 16 paragraph shall require a broadcast of any portion of a 17 meeting that is conducted in executive session and nothing in this paragraph shall be deemed to waive or modify any 18 19 law related to public records, public meetings or the 20 legislature. The failure of broadcasting capability shall 21 not delay the proceedings of any meeting, and no broadcast shall be required under this paragraph where broadcasting 22 capability is not reasonably available. The failure to 23

2	affect the validity of any action taken at a meeting.
