for

1 AN ACT relating to wildlife and livestock; removing the
2 delayed effective date for a prior act related to bighorn
3 and domestic sheep relocation and making the prior act
4 effective by contingency; repealing a duplicative effective
5 date; and providing for an effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** 2024 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 105,
10 Section 4 is amended to read:

12 **Section 4.** This act is effective
13 not later than fifteen (15) days after
14 applicable federal law is enacted and

1 the attorney general certifies to the
2 secretary of state that federal law has
3 been enacted that aligns with the
4 purposes of this act. ~~If no federal law~~
5 ~~is enacted that aligns with the~~
6 ~~purposes of this act, this act is~~
7 ~~effective January 1, 2026.~~

9 **Section 2.** 2024 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 105,
10 Section 5 is repealed.

11
12 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
15 Constitution.
