A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to legal time and holidays; designating
2 Wyoming Wednesday as a state recognized commemorative day
3 to be observed as specified; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 8-4-118 is created to read:

9

10 **8-4-118. Wyoming Wednesday.**

12 (a) In celebration of the state of Wyoming and in an
13 effort to bring unity to the state's communities, every
14 Wednesday shall be known as "Wyoming Wednesday - Brown and

1 Gold Day". Wyoming citizens may wear brown and gold on
2 Wednesdays in recognition of Wyoming Wednesday.

3

4 (b) The governor, not later than August 1, 2025, and
5 not more than once each year thereafter in advance of a
6 Wyoming Wednesday, shall issue a proclamation requesting
7 proper observance of "Wyoming Wednesday - Brown and Gold
8 Day" as outlined in subsection (a) of this section.

9

10 (c) This section shall not affect commercial paper,
11 the making or execution of written agreements or judicial
12 proceedings, or authorize public schools, businesses or
13 state and local government offices to close.

14

15 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2025.
