For purposes of this section, 2 "drone" means an unmanned aircraft weighing not more than 3 fifty-five (55) pounds on takeoff, including everything 4 that is on board or otherwise attached to the unmanned aircraft. 5 6 7 (b) Criminal trespass by drone is a misdemeanor 8 punishable by imprisonment for not more than six (6) 9 months, a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or both. 10 11 12 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2025. 13 14 (END)
