1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming national guard; providing 2 legislative findings; prohibiting the release of the Wyoming national guard into active duty combat 3 as 4 specified; and providing for an effective date. 5 б Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. The Wyoming legislature finds that this 8 9 act, creating the Defend the Guard Act, follows the 10 principles embodied in the United States constitution and the writings of the founders. Article I, section 8 of the 11 12 United States constitution vests in the congress the exclusive power to declare war. By abdicating the war 13 14 powers to the executive branch, the United States congress

2 (ii) "Official declaration of war" means an 3 official declaration of war made by the United States 4 congress pursuant to article I, section 8, clause 11 of the 5 United States constitution.

7 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the 8 Wyoming national guard and any member thereof shall not be released from the state into active duty combat unless the 9 10 United States congress has passed an official declaration 11 of war or has taken an official action pursuant to article 12 I, section 8, clause 15 of the United States constitution to explicitly call forth the Wyoming national guard and any 13 14 member thereof for the enumerated purposes of expressly executing the laws of the union, repelling invasion or 15 16 suppressing an insurrection. The governor shall take all 17 actions necessary to comply with the requirements of this 18 section.

(d) Nothing in this section limits or prohibits the governor from consenting to the deployment of any Wyoming national guard member under title 32 of the United States Code for the purpose of providing defense support for civil
