- 1 AN ACT relating to the administration of the government;

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 9-2-1012(e) and 9-2-1013(d)(ii) are
- 10 amended to read:

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- 12 9-2-1012. Duties of the department; transmittal of
- 13 standard budget and manual; return of completed exception
- 14 and expanded budgets; submission to governor; disposition
- 15 of excess general fund appropriations; submission of

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1 selected budget information to joint appropriations

2 committee.

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4 (e) In preparing the overall state budget for 5 distribution the legislature, including to supplemental, budget shortfall or other emergency changes 6 to the budget, the governor shall recommend to 7 the 8 legislature that not less than five percent (5%) ten 9 percent (10%) of estimated general fund receipts for the 10 next biennial budget period shall be appropriated from the 11 general fund to the budget reserve account within the 12 earmarked fund. This appropriation shall be in addition to any fund balance within the budget reserve account. At the 13 each biennial budget period, general 14 end of 15 appropriations for the biennium in excess of expenditures 16 including encumbrances during the biennium, as identified 17 by the state auditor in accordance with the provisions of W.S. 9-2-1008 and 9-4-207, shall be transferred into the 18 19 budget reserve account. All funds in the budget reserve 20 account shall be invested by the state treasurer and 21 earnings therefrom shall be credited into the general fund. Appropriations to the account shall not lapse at the end of 22

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- 1 any fiscal period. Expenditures from the budget reserve
- 2 account shall be by legislative appropriation only.

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- 4 9-2-1013. State budget; distribution of copies to

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- 8 (d) In addition to the items contained in subsection
- 9 (a) of this section and notwithstanding any other
- 10 recommendations made by the governor, the state budget
- 11 shall also include the governor's recommendations for
- 12 appropriations for the ensuing two (2) years, or if a
- 13 supplemental budget request, the remainder of the budget
- 14 period, subject to the following:

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- 16 (ii) The total recommended appropriations under
- 17 this subsection for any two (2) fiscal year budget period
- 18 shall not exceed the total estimated revenues for that two
- 19 (2) year period. The total estimated revenues computed
- 20 under this paragraph shall not include increases in
- 21 existing revenue sources which would be available to the
- 22 state only after enactment of legislation in addition to
- 23 existing law, but shall include the unencumbered balances

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in all other accounts in all other expendable funds subject 1 2 to this section, and as further provided herein, as those are identified in accordance with standards 3 funds 4 promulgated by the governmental accounting standards board, but specifically excluding pension funds, nonexpendable 5 trust funds, debt service funds and intragovernmental 6 funds, that would be available for that budget period. 7 8 Funds within the permanent Wyoming mineral trust fund reserve account created under W.S. 9-4-719(b), the common 9 10 school permanent fund reserve account created under W.S. 9-4-719(f), funds within the legislative stabilization 11 12 reserve account in excess of the limitation under 13 subparagraph (iii)(C) of this section, or funds within five percent (5%) ten percent (10%) of estimated general fund 14 receipts for the next biennium to be appropriated to the 15 16 budget reserve account as required by W.S. 9-2-1012(e) shall not be included in total estimated revenues computed 17 under this paragraph. Funds from a contingent 18 19 appropriation shall not be included as an estimated source 20 of revenue or funds available unless those funds previously 21 had been authorized to be expended within the fiscal period covering the budget period of the recommendation; 22

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1 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
