1	(e) A governmental entity shall be immune from
2	liability for any tort associated with any claim arising
3	solely from or related to a public employee's use, or
4	failure to use, a firearm. For purposes of this subsection,
5	a public employee who is acting within the scope of his
6	duty when using or failing to use a firearm shall be
7	entitled to a defense at the governmental entity's expense
8	in accordance with subsection (b) of this section.
