## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to children; authorizing parents and guardians to enter into binding settlements on behalf of 2 their minor children as specified; specifying limits on 3 parental or quardian settlement authority; amending the

value of property that may be delivered on a child's 5

behalf; authorizing the entry of binding settlements on a 6

7 minor child's behalf as specified; making conforming

8 amendments; providing a cause of action; specifying

9 applicability; and providing for an effective date.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

13 **Section 1**. W.S. 3-3-108(a)(intro) and (b) and

Payment or delivery of property in lieu of 2 conservatorship. 3 4 (a) Any person under a duty to pay or deliver money or personal property to a minor for whom no conservator has 5 been appointed may pay not more than five thousand dollars 6 (\$5,000.00)—twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) per 7 8 annum or may deliver property of a value not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) twenty-five thousand dollars 9 10 (\$25,000.00) to: 11 12 (b) The payment or the delivery provided in W.S. 3-3-108 this section shall not be made if the person has 13 actual knowledge that a conservator has been appointed or 14 proceedings for appointment of a conservator of the estate 15 16 of the minor are pending. 17 18 14-2-202. 7 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00);

9 (iv) The moneys paid under the settlement

10 agreement or compromise are paid:

12 (A) To the parent, guardian or conservator

13 of the minor; or

15 (B) Into a trust or other account held for

16 the benefit of the minor.

18 (v) The parent, guardian or conservator of the

19 minor attests in an affidavit that the person has made a

20 reasonable inquiry into the minor's claim and that:

22 (A) The total amount of the minor's claim

23 is not greater than twenty-five thousand dollars

1	(\$25,000.00), excluding fees, costs and all other expenses
2	incident to the claim; and

4	(B) To the best of the parent's, guardian's
5	or conservator's knowledge:

7	(I) The minor will be fully
8	compensated by the settlement or compromise; or

10	(II) It is unlikely that the minor
11	will be able to obtain additional amounts from the party
12	entering into the settlement agreement or compromise with
13	the minor.

15	(vi) The parent, guardian or conservator of the
16	minor will apply the funds received to the use and benefit
17	of the minor.

19	(d) A settlement or compromise entered into in
20	compliance with subsection (c) of this section shall, upon
21	signature of the parent, guardian or conservator entering
22	into the agreement on the minor's behalf, be binding on the
23	minor without the need for further court approval or review

2 were a competent adult entering into the settlement or 3 compromise. 4 (e) A minor shall have a cause of action against a 5 parent, guardian or conservator who fails to manage or 6 7 apply all funds received for the sole benefit of the minor, 8 who fails to make a reasonable inquiry into the minor's claim, who falsely states that the minor's claim is not 9 10 greater than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) to 11 settle the claim under this section or who otherwise fails 12 to comply with the requirements of this section in settling 13 a claim on behalf of the minor. 14 Section 2. This act shall only apply to settlements 15 or compromises entered into for minors on and after the 16 17 effective date of this act. 18 19 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2025. 20 21 (END)
