7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 41-10-113(a)(xi) is amended to read:

11 41-10-113. Powers of district board.

13 (a) For and on behalf of the district the board of

14 any district shall have the following powers:

15

1 (xi) Except as otherwise provided in this act, 2 enter into contracts and agreements affecting the 3 affairs of the district, including but not limited to 4 contracts with the United States of America and any of its agencies or instrumentalities, and contracts with 5 municipality or district for the operation of a common or 6 jointly owned project. Any improvement or improvements of 7 any nature made in any district where the entire cost, 8 9 value or amount of such work including labor and materials exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) 10 shall seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00), except such 11 12 work done by employees of the district with supplies and materials purchased by it as hereinafter provided or except 13 by labor or supplies and materials, or all of such, 14 supplied under agreement with the United States of America, 15 16 the state of Wyoming, or any federal or state agency, 17 instrumentality or corporation, or other political subdivision, shall be done only under independent contract 18 19 entered into by the district with the lowest 20 responsible bidder submitting the lowest and best bid upon 21 proper terms after due public notice by publication has been given asking for competitive bids. The district shall 22 have the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any 23

1 irregularity in any bid. Any contract may be let on a lump 2 sum or unit basis. No contract shall be entered into for 3 such work unless the contractor shall give an undertaking 4 with a sufficient surety or sureties approved by the board and in an amount fixed by the board for the faithful 5 default the contract. Upon 6 performance of in the any contract, the proper official 7 performance of 8 advertise and relet the remainder of the work without further resolution and deduct the cost from the original 9 10 contract price and recover any excess cost by suit on the original bond, or otherwise. The district shall have the 11 12 power to make any improvement, or portion thereof, in any district, directly by the officers, agents and employees of 13 the district, with supplies and materials purchased or 14 15 otherwise acquired therefor. All supplies, materials, equipment, machinery and apparatus purchased by the board 16 17 for any district (but not by a contractor) costing thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) seventy-five thousand dollars 18 19 (\$75,000.00) or more shall be purchased only after notice 20 by publication for competitive bids. The district shall 21 accept the lowest bid, kind, quality and material being equal, but the district shall have the right to reject any 22 and all bids, to waive any irregularity in any bid, and to 23
