W.S. 35-11-1103 is amended to read: 11 12 35-11-1103. Property exempt from ad valorem taxation. 13 The following property is exempt from ad valorem taxation 14 15 pursuant to the provisions of this act and includes

1 facilities, installations, machinery or equipment attached 2 or unattached to real property and designed, installed and 3 utilized primarily for the elimination, control or 4 prevention of air, water or land pollution, or in the event such facility, installation, equipment or machinery shall 5 also serve other beneficial purposes and use, such portion 6 of the assessed valuation thereof as may be reasonably 7 8 calculated to be necessary for and devoted to elimination, control or prevention of air, water and land pollution. The 9 10 department of revenue shall determine the exempt portion on 11 all property assessed pursuant to W.S. 39-13-102(m). The 12 county assessor shall determine the exempt portion on all 13 property assessed pursuant to W.S. 39-13-103(b). The determination shall not include as exempt any portion of 14 15 any facilities which have value as the specific source of 16 marketable byproducts. For purposes of this section and 17 W.S. 39-11-105(a)(xx), carbon dioxide shall not be 18 considered air, water or land pollution.
