1 AN ACT relating to taxation; clarifying the taxability of

- 2 state owned lands; providing a sunset date; creating a task
- 3 force to study and provide recommendations related to the

- 6 and providing for an effective date.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-11-105(a)(ii)(intro) and by
- 11 creating a new paragraph (xlvi) is amended to read:

13 **39-11-105.** Exemptions.

14

- 15 (a) The following property is exempt from property
- 16 taxation:

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1 2 (ii) Subject to paragraph (xlvi) of this 3 subsection, property of the state of Wyoming that is owned 4 and used primarily for a governmental purpose is exempt 5 from property taxation. The following property is not owned and used primarily for a governmental purpose: 6 7 8 (xlvi) Lands owned by the state of Wyoming are 9 exempt from property taxation regardless of the use of the 10 lands. Nothing in this paragraph shall prevent the taxation of any other property, including improvements to land, that 11 12 are not owned and used primarily for a governmental purpose 13 as provided in paragraph (ii) of this subsection. This 14 paragraph is repealed January 1, 2027. 15 16 Section 2. The property tax exemption provided in W.S. 39-11-105(a)(xlvi) as created in section 1 of this act 17 18 shall apply to the tax year beginning January 1, 2025. 19 20 Section 3. 21 22 (a) There is created the government property task 23 force to consist of four (4) members appointed by the

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1 speaker of the house, four (4) members appointed by the

2 president of the senate and two (2) members appointed by

3 the governor.

5 (b) The task force shall:

6

7 (i) Review the taxability of government property

8 considering the historical taxation of government property

9 and the impacts of the recent Wyoming supreme court

10 decision dealing with the taxability of state lands;

11

12 (ii) Review the exemptions for different types

13 of government property including federal, state, municipal,

14 county, school and other public property;

15

16 (iii) Make recommendations regarding the

17 taxability of state lands and other government property.

18 The recommendations may include any recommendations to

19 amend the exemptions for government property among the

20 different types of government property to make those

21 exemptions uniform and to clarify the definition of

22 "governmental purpose".

1 (c) Not later than October 1, 2025 the task force

2 shall report to the governor, the joint revenue interim

3 committee and the joint agriculture, state and public lands

4 and water resources interim committee on the activities of

5 the task force and any recommendations of the task force

6 under this section.

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8 (d) The legislative members of the task force shall

9 receive compensation, per diem and travel expenses in the

10 manner and amount prescribed by W.S. 28-5-101. Task force

11 members who are not legislators and are not state employees

12 shall receive the compensation, per diem and mileage paid

13 to members of the Wyoming legislature under W.S. 28-5-101.

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15 (e) The task force shall be staffed by the

16 legislative service office. The department of revenue and

17 the office of state lands and investments shall provide

18 assistance to the task force upon request.

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20 (f) The task force shall terminate June 30, 2026.

22 Section 4.

There is appropriated twenty thousand dollars

2 (\$20,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's office compensation, 3 pay mileage and per diem for 4 nonlegislative members of the task force. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the 5 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2026. This 6 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 7

8 other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

9 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided

10 by law on June 30, 2026.

11

12 There is appropriated forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) from the general fund to the legislative 13 service office to pay for salary, mileage and per diem of 14 legislative members appointed to the task force. 15 This 16 appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the 17 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2026. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 18 19 unexpended, unobligated purpose and any 20 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 21 by law on June 30, 2026.
