1 (iii) "Sport or recreational opportunity" means 2 commonly understood sporting activities including but not 3 limited to baseball, softball, football, soccer, 4 basketball, swimming, hockey, wrestling, cheerleading, 5 rodeo, dude ranching, nordic or alpine skiing and other alpine sports, snowboarding, mountain climbing, outdoor 6 education programs, river floating, hunting, fishing, 7 8 backcountry trips, horseback riding and any other equine activity, snowmobiling, agritourism and similar 9 10 recreational opportunities and includes the use of private lands for vehicle parking and land access related to the 11 sport or recreational opportunity. "Sport or recreational 12 opportunity" does not include skiing in a ski area as 13 defined by the Ski Safety Act; 14
