A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; allowing children to enroll in any public school within their resident school district 2 3 as specified; providing exceptions; providing priority for specified requiring reporting 4 students; by school districts; amending the duties of the school district board 5 of trustees; requiring the state superintendent of public 6 7 instruction to publish reported information; making

conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

Schools to be free and accessible to all 8 children; minimum school year; open enrollment. 9 10 (c) Commencing with school year 2026-2027 and each 11 school year thereafter, the board of trustees of each school district within the state shall provide for the 12 enrollment of any pupil in any public school within the 13 pupil's resident school district, except as otherwise 14 provided in subsection (d) of this section. For purposes of 15 16 this subsection: 17 "Resident school district" means the school 18 (i) 19 district where the pupil resides; 20 21 (ii) "School attendance area" means a geographic
