(ii) The procedure to be followed in the proceeding before the district court shall be in accordance with rules heretofore or hereinafter adopted by the Wyoming supreme court;

1	(iii) All administrative remedies shall be
2	exhausted before a person seeks judicial review;

4	(iv) There is no statutory or common-law
5	provision that precludes or limits judicial review;

7	(v) The right of judicial review under this
8	subsection shall not apply to any action or inaction taken
9	in regards to the public employment of a person, unless:

18	inactions taken on and after July 1, 2025.
