A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; amending the
2 requirement for persons convicted of felony voyeurism to
3 register as a sex offender; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 7-19-302(g) is amended to read:

9

10 **7-19-302. Registration of offenders; procedure;**
11 **verification; fees.**

13 (g) For an offender convicted of a violation of W.S.
14 6-2-316(a)(i) and (iv), 6-2-705, 6-4-303(b)(iv) or
15 6-4-304(b), ~~if the victim was a minor,~~ 18 U.S.C. §§ 2252B,

1 2252C, 2424 and 2425, an offense in another jurisdiction
2 containing the same or similar elements, or arising out of
3 the same or similar facts or circumstances as a criminal
4 offense specified in this subsection or an attempt or
5 conspiracy to commit any of the offenses specified in this
6 subsection, the division shall annually verify the accuracy
7 of the offender's registered address, and the offender
8 shall annually report, in person, his current address to
9 the sheriff in the county in which the offender resides,
10 during the period in which he is required to register.
11 During the annual in-person verification, the sheriff shall
12 photograph the offender. Confirmation of the in-person
13 verification required under this subsection, along with the
14 photograph of the offender, shall be transmitted by the
15 sheriff to the division within three (3) working days. Any
16 person under this subsection who has not established a
17 residence or is transient, and who is reporting to the
18 sheriff as required under subsection (e) of this section,
19 shall be deemed in compliance with the address verification
20 requirements of this section.
