## A BILL

## for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; authorizing county 2 treasurers to accept applications and payment for wildlife 3 conservation license plates; amending application requirements; requiring rulemaking; and providing for 4 5 effective dates. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-231(a), (b)(intro) and (c) is 10 amended to read: 11 12 31-2-231. Wildlife conservation license plates; 13 wildlife conservation account; authority to receive and 14 expend monies. 15

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1 (a) Any person required to register a vehicle in 2 Wyoming pursuant to this article may apply to the 3 department or county treasurer for a statement of 4 eligibility for wildlife conservation license plates for any motor vehicle that is not a commercial vehicle or 5 multipurpose vehicle owned or leased by that person upon 6 registration of the vehicle. The department or county 7 8 treasurer may include as part of the application the option for the applicant to donate an additional amount in support 9 10 wildlife conservation efforts related of to the transportation system. Upon payment by the applicant of a 11 12 fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) to the department or county treasurer, plus any additional 13 voluntary amount, the department or county treasurer shall 14 issue a written statement of eligibility for wildlife 15 16 conservation license plates. The department or county 17 treasurer shall assess an annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a person to retain eligibility for wildlife 18 19 conservation plates, but this annual fee shall not be 20 charged in the year the person pays the one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) eligibility fee. The person may submit an 21 additional voluntary amount 22 in support of wildlife

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conservation efforts related to the transportation system
when remitting the annual fee.

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4 (b) The fees collected under subsection (a) of this section shall be payable to the department or county 5 treasurer and shall be accounted for separately. Except as 6 otherwise provided by law, the fees collected under 7 8 subsection (a) of this section and funds collected under W.S. 23-2-101(p), 23-2-201(h), 23-2-306(d), 24-1-131(b), 9 10 31-2-225(a)(vi), 31-2-404(f)(ii), 31-2-409(h)(ii), 31-2-703(e)(ii), 31-3-101(j), 31-7-111(b)(xiv) and 11 12 36-4-121(t) shall be distributed to the wildlife conservation account within the state highway fund, which 13 is hereby created. The wildlife conservation account shall 14 be administered in accordance with the following: 15

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(c) Applicants shall apply at least thirty (30) days before registration is required for the vehicle for which the plates are intended. Except as provided in this section, application for, issuance and renewal of the wildlife conservation license plates under this section shall be subject to the same requirements and fees as provided in this article in addition to the fee collected

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1 under subsection (a) of this section. The license plate 2 fees required under W.S. 31-3-102(a)(viii) shall accompany 3 each application. The license plates under this section 4 shall be issued by the county treasurer of each county and shall be displayed only upon the vehicle for which they are 5 issued. 6 7 8 **Section 2.** The department of transportation shall adopt all rules necessary to implement this act. 9 10 Section 3. 11 12 13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this act is effective immediately upon completion 14 of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided 15 16 by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 17 (b) Section 1 of this act is effective July 1, 2025. 18 19 20 (END)

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
