16 the projects specified and any unexpended, unobligated funds
17 remaining upon completion of a project shall revert to the accounts
18 from which they were appropriated, unless otherwise provided. The
19 amounts appropriated in this section are intended to provide a
20 maximum amount for each project from any source, excluding
21 contingency funding, and shall not be construed to be an
22 entitlement or guaranteed amount:

9 (iii) Wyoming community college commission - industrial technology

15 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, after funds are obligated
16 for all studies specified in subsection (a) of this footnote, any remaining
17 unobligated funds from this appropriation are authorized for expenditure on any
18 level I, level II and master plan studies approved by the state building
19 commission.

21 2. The state construction department is authorized to retain a qualified
22 owner's representative for the veterans' home of Wyoming remodel. From this
23 general fund appropriation, the department may expend an amount not to exceed
24 five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for retention of the qualified
25 owner's representative.

27 3. (a) Federal funds received by the state of Wyoming for state run veterans'
28 home facilities shall:

30 (i) Be deposited to the legislative stabilization reserve account
31 in an equivalent amount of expended general funds to the extent funds from this

56 (a) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2026, and subject to

1 W.S. 9-4-207(d)(iv), there is appropriated two hundred thirty-two
2 million nine hundred seventy-nine thousand four hundred forty
3 dollars (\$232,979,440.00) from the general fund for major
4 maintenance to the entities and in the amounts specified as
5 provided in this subsection. This appropriation shall be
6 distributed as follows:

7
8 (i) Thirty-seven and six tenths percent (37.6%) to the
9 state construction department for state buildings, facilities and
10 sites managed by the state building commission and state
11 institutions;

12
13 (ii) Seven and ninety-nine hundredths percent (7.99%)
14 to the department of state parks and cultural resources to fund
15 major maintenance requests submitted by the department of state
16 parks and cultural resources as approved by the state building
17 commission;

18
19 (iii) Thirty-six and thirty-four hundredths percent
20 (36.34%) to the University of Wyoming for university buildings,
21 facilities and sites, excluding student housing, the student union
22 and auxiliary services areas, the latter being those areas funded
23 by university self-sustaining revenues;

24
25 (iv) Eighteen and seven hundredths percent (18.07%) to
26 the state construction department for community college district
27 buildings, facilities and sites."
